- 1.) βλέπω = I see
- 2.) ἀποστέλλω = I send forth, send away
- 3.) ἀμήν = a transliteration of the Hebrew אָמֵן, pronounced exactly the same and meaning "truly."
Understand that when reading this word, a Greek reader would not be reading a Greek word, but something from Hebrew.
- 4.) νεκρός = dead
- 5.) δοῦλος = slave
- 6.) ὅταν = when, whenever
- 7.) αἰών = age
- 8.) ἀρχιερεὺς = high priest, chief priest
- 9.) βάλλω = I throw
- 10.) θάνατος = death
- 11.) δύναμις = power
- 12.) παραδίδωμι = I hand over, deliver

the Declension of the Definite Article

^{2nd} masculine

Just as nouns are declined, their articles are declined in the same way. Below are the declensions of articles by themselves and then the declensions with the exemplary λόγος. (masculine)

	<u>sing.</u>	<u>plur.</u>
N -	ὁ	οἱ
G -	τοῦ	τῶν
A -	τοῦ	τῶν
L -	τῷ	τοῖς
D -	τῷ	τοῖς
I -	τῷ	τοῖς
A -	τόν	τούς
V -	—	—

λόγος:

<u>sing.</u>	<u>plur.</u>
ὁ λόγος	οἱ λόγοι
τοῦ λόγου	τῶν λογῶν
τοῦ λόγου	τῶν λογῶν
τῷ λόγῳ	τοῖς λόγοις
τῷ λόγῳ	τοῖς λόγοις
τῷ λόγῳ	τοῖς λόγοις
τόν λόγον	τούς λόγους

Note that, with the exception of the singular nominative, the article is declined just as its corresponding noun.
